

Payette, Idaho April 7th, 1919

The Board of County Commissioners of Payette County, having met for the purpose of canvassing the votes cast at the election held on April 5th 1919 for the purpose of forming a Highway District under the State Laws, of the State of Idaho, out of territory formerly comprising Good Roads District No. 1 of said County.

Present A.C. Cogswell, J.M. Davis and J.A. White.

Canvass of Votes for  
Highway District No. 1

Mr. White moved that after opening the returns from said Election, and canvassing the same we find as follows:

At the New Plymouth voting place there were 43 votes cast. Of the votes so cast 39 were "Highway District Yes". Four were "Highway District No."

At the Fruitland voting place there were 196 votes cast, of the votes so cast 184 were "Highway District yes". 11 were "Highway District No". One was blank.

Making a total of votes cast in the said District of 239. Of the votes so cast 223 were "Highway District yes". 15 were "Highway District No." 1 was blank. Therefore a majority of all votes cast being "Highway District yes; we therefore order and decree as follows:

DECREE FORMING HIGHWAY  
DISTRICT NO. 1

That Highway District Number One of Payette County is hereby created, and the territory described in the petition in this matter, and hereinafter set out, be and the same is hereby duly organized as a Highway District under the name designated in said Petition to wit:

"Highway District Number One of Payette County Idaho: The Boundaries thereof are as follows to wit: Beginning at the Southeast corner of Section thirty-six (36) Township Seven (7) North, Range four (4) West; thence West three (3) miles to the South West corner of Section thirty four (34) of said Township and Range, thence North three miles to the Southwest corner of Section Fifteen (15), of said Township and Range, thence west to the center of the channel of Snake River, thence following the channel of the Snake River north to the west side of the right of way of the Oregon Short Line Railway in Section Eight (8), Township Eight (8) North, Range Five (5) West, thence following the West line of the right-of-way to the middle of the channel of the Payette River thence following in a Southeasterly direction of the channel of the Payette River to the East line of Section Twelve (12), Township Seven (7) North, Range Four (4) West of the Boise Meridian, thence South to the point of beginning.

All the above described tract of land excepting therefrom the Village of New Plymouth.

Members voting yes. Cogswell-Davis- White So the motion prevailed.

No further business being in order the Board adjourned.
