The Board of Commissioners met at the District office located at 3890 NW 1st Avenue, New Plymouth Idaho for their Regular Board Meeting. Present were Commissioner's Dave Levanger, Eric York and Ryan Henggeler via speaker phone, Director of Highways Tim Hinson and Clerk Wendy Adamsen. At 4:10 P.M. the meeting was called to order by Chairman David Levanger.

The Commissioners received a copy of the minutes from the August 8, 2023 Regular Board meeting and the Budget Hearing held on August 29, 2023; the minutes were approved as written.

The Clerk gave the financial report. The balance at First Interstate checking will be \$1,067.44 after the transfer from the LGIP and the September 12, 2023 bills are paid; the September 12, 2023 bills totaled \$71,379.21. The balance at the LGIP will be \$699,689.27 after the transfer to the First Interstate checking in the amount of \$71,300.00. The balance at Idaho Central Credit Union savings is \$25.00. The total road and bridge fund balance is \$700,781.71.

New Business:

1) Tim informed the Board that Gayle Hagler has informed him that the cow hauling business that tried to put their business on NW $1^{\rm st}$ is now interested in purchasing 10 acres off of Auto Drive. Tim then stated that if they go thru with the purchase it will create an industrial sub-division which would then require them to pave the roads to District standards; lastly he stated that Mike Davis is looking into it.

Old Business:

1) The Clerk presented the personnel policy that had the two changes regarding comp time and the sick bank; Eric moved to adopt the policy, Ryan seconded the motion and it was carried.

Clerks Report:

1) The Clerk presented a spreadsheet to the Board that showed the line overages for F2023 and stated the accounts she would like to use to zero out the accounts, after some discussion the Board stated that she could use the accounts she mentioned.

Director of Highways Report:

1) Tim stated that the grader patching is finished, the crew is now working on getting the remaining 3/4" road mix hauled in to wrap up the budget year.

According to Idaho Code §31-1605 it is possible for the Commissioner's to adjust the budget line items without a public hearing as long as there is no money added or subtracted from the revenue portion of the budget; therefore, below are the following line item changes that were made to the F2023 budget:
