

The following Resolution 2022-3 was introduced by Clerk, Wendy Adamsen, read in full, considered and adopted:

WHEREAS, the Board of Highway District No. 1 consider implementing a private sign policy; and


WHEREAS, private signs will include but not limited to campaign signs, real-estate signs and yard sale signs; and

WHEREAS, private signs will not be allowed within Highway District road rights of way which is 30' off the center of the road nor will private signs be allowed within 300' from an intersection or pinned to any and all informational traffic signs posted by the Highway District; and

WHEREAS, any private signs that violate this policy will be removed by Highway District personnel and held at the District shop for 5 business days; furthermore, all private signs must be picked up within 10 days of an election, sale of real-estate or yard sale.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Highway District No. 1 consider implementing a private sign policy. Private signs will include but not be limited to campaign signs, real-estate signs and yard sale signs. Private signs will not be allowed within 30' of Highway District rights of way nor will they be allowed within 300' of an intersection or pinned to any and all information traffics signs posted the Highway District. Any private signs that violate this policy will be removed by Highway District personnel and held at the District shop for 5 business days; furthermore, all private signs must be picked up within 10 days of an election, sale of real-estate or yard sale.
